### **Participants**

All ISU members and clubs, members of National Figure Skating Federations associated to ISU, are invited to take part in the competition. The results for Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice, Advanced Novice, Junior and Senior will be calculated according to latest ISU regulations. All other categories and beginners will be calculated according to the Estonian Figure Skating Union Adapted Classification for Youngsters for season 2025/2026. In case of force majeure circumstances, which are beyond of control of the organizer, such as epidemiological situation, war, military operations or political situation or other circumstances, the organizer is entitled to cancel or postpone the event without having any related penalties. In case of circumstances, which are beyond of control of the organizer, the organizer has the right to change the venue of the competition without having any related penalties.

The deadline for entries is October 27, 2025 23:59 local time.

- The competitor is included in the entry list only after a 100% payment.
- In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category and class. The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason, except when the Organizer has to reduce the entries.

#### AWARDS

Medals or trophies shall be awarded to the first three standings of each category/class. All competitors shall receive a diploma and present at the awarding ceremony.

#### MUSIC

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee through the Sportity Online Registration System (https://fs.sportity.com/) by latest November 3rd 2025.

The submission must be of a fine quality encoded in either MP3 or WAW format with normalised level audio. The OC cannot guarantee quality playback for music submitted in other than the above-mentioned format. Each music submission must also contain the name of the track, composer, singer and/or author in the Title field of the Online Registration form. Competitors have the opportunity to validate their music either within the registration system before the event or at the OC Office / Accreditation Office at the Ice Rink. Any music changes must be done latest 48h before the beginning of the first segment of the competition. Any later changes must be coordinated with the OC on-site. In accordance to the

Estonian Skating Federation rules as well as the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024 the Special Regulations Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2024 each skater and his/her lawful representative is solely responsible for the music rights and licenses for their program's music. The OC will take no responsibility for licensing the program/performance music. Each Competitor must also have its own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in WAV or MP3 format.

#### RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2024, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used. Intermidiate and final results will be published on competition website and in Sportity App event channel. There will be no hard-copy distribution of any printed media on this event. All required information will be available on the Information Board at the Ice Rink and on Digital Info Board (Sportity App). The protocol will be available: Sportity app (EVENT PASSWORD KJOPEN2).

#### **PROTESTS**

Each team has the right to file a protest. Protests must be submitted to the Referee of the relevant event in writing immediately after the event and not later than 30 minutes after the end of the segment. Protests against incorrect mathematical calculation may be filed until 24 hours after the completion of the competition concerned. Protests may be filed by Competitors or the club's official representatives. Upon the submission of the protest a protest fee of 50 EUR must be paid. The referee's decision is final. No protests against evaluations by Referees, Judges and the Technical Panel. (Technical Controller, Technical Specialists) of Skaters' performances are allowed.

#### DRAW AND TIME SCHEDULE

An electronic draw will be published on Sportity app ((EVENT PASSWORD KJOPEN2). There will be no draw after short programs. Starting order for free programs will be according to reverse order of the results from short programs. Preliminary time schedule will be published after the deadline for entries, and it will be available in Sportity app (EVENT PASSWORD KJOPEN2).
